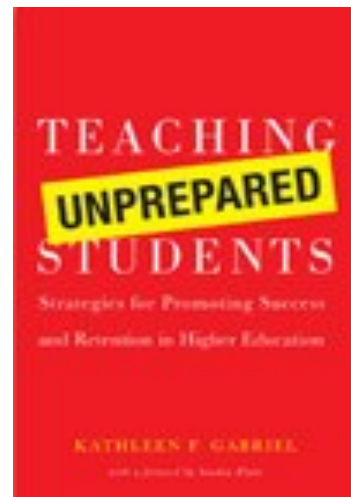
Teaching Underprepared Students: Strategies for Promoting Success and Retention in Higher Education
