DW Curriculum	Bennett	District Wide Curriculum Process of new programs offered at sister campuses.  Bruce Maule presented information regarding CSM and Skyline's CPA Tax Preparation course. CSM faculty claimed they were mislead on opening day, being told by Skyline that Skyline would not create CPA

		prep courses; Skyline faculty apparently copied and pasted all CSM CPA prep courses, and submitted to COI; Skyline faculty apparently did not		
		respond to Curricunet questions, regarding similar courses at other district colleges, and consultation. Possibility of enrollment declining at		
		CSM and running both programs would put both programs in jeopardy of cancellation. CSM 's accounting faculty requested that Skyline's program not be offered in Fall in order to maintain a robust program at CSM. All DAS members, at the time, based on the presentation, felt		
		there should be a delay in Skyline offering the courses this fall.		
		President Bennett reported her meeting with VP Council. VP Council and President Bennett are in conversation to develop a collaborative process district wide for program offerings. The researchers will provide data going back two years for the next VP Council meeting  It was also suggested that both colleges monitor the program for a year District Senate will work with the District Curriculum committee to review the process within CurricUNET.
