			But she is now concerned that the course outlines are	
			confusing to the students. The CSM course is degree	
			credit, but the Skyline course is not – and the courses	
			are identical. This is a disservice to students. She	
			showed these materials to the other college COI chairs.	
			There will be a meeting 3/16 for all stakeholders. Teresa	
			will be there. There is talk that Skyline is involved in a	
			partnership with NDNU. Some courses have gone	

			through unit changes at the two colleges, but not in a coherent manner. Communication has broken down not only with faculty, according to Teresa. Some discussion about possible changes to Curricunet, to enhance the communication. Possibility of a district COI, to which all college COI's must submit all courses.
