REIMBURSABLE ACTIVITIES - FROM THE FILED TEST CLAIM (This is a part of the School Facilities Funding Requirements K-14 test claim. This portion pertains to utilization of "Mello-Roos Districts")

Pursuant to Education Code sections 15300 -15425, for eligible school districts, county offices of education, and community college districts, the direct and indirect cost of the following activities are reimbursable:

- 1. Formation of a District
- A. RESOLUTION: Preparing a resolution, and modifications thereof, of intention to form the proposed school facilities improvement district which includes a statement of the intended use of the funds, estimate of the cost of the facilities, map of the boundaries of the district, notice of time and place of hearing.
- B. NOTICE: Providing notice of hearings by publication in a newspaper of general circulation and posting the notice.
- C. HEARINGS: Conducting the hearings in the manner proscribed.
- 2. Bond Election
- A. COE REPORT: Submitting an annual report to the county superintendent of schools with jurisdiction over the district containing the information pertaining to the election.
- B. ELECTION: Conducting the bond election in accordance with the Elections Codes. Preparing the ballots in the required method.
- C. CERTIFICATION: Certifying to the county board of supervisors the results of the election.
- 3. Issuance, Sale, and Maintenance of the Bonds

Reimbursing the county board of supervisors, or direct payment of the cost of preparation, sale, delivery, and maintenance of the school facilities improvement bonds, including financial consultants, publication and notice of sale, rating, printing, and legal fees of bond counsel.

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
