Slide 8 - Successful Course Completion Rate by Category (2011/12)

What ideas come to mind about the huge gaps?

Black group – Is age relevant? What programs are available to support Black students? More detailed information would be an asset. How can completion rate improve for this group? What can the college do as a whole?

Day/evening – Why are they doing better? Does age matter?

Slide 16 - College Fall-to-Fall Persistence Rate by category

Why are students leaving? What is there goal? What information do we still need?

Slide 20 - College Success Rate in Student's First Year by category

What contributes to their success? What support services are available?

Slide 28 - College Success Rate in CTE Courses by category

Students are goal driven. Look at groups where there is success as a starting point to figure out ways to support the rest of the students.

Slide 32 - College Success Rate in Pre-Transfer Courses by category

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How many of these students are DRC students? Currently, there are no funds available to provide the services to students who need them.

Slide 36 - College Success Rate in ESL Courses by category
Tutoring services are not available for evening students. Could this be a factor which is contributing this low success rate?

Slide 63 - Percent of Students Placed into Pre-transfer Math that take Pre-transfer Math in their first term. If the math/engl placement is not working, what can we do to make it better?

Initiative to eliminate Engl/Math assessment and look at programs like those implemented at Chabot College. Place these recommendations in the student equity plan.
