  1. CDTC: Val/Cece [ab]
    - a. Canada = short last year & this year, had to send back units; -150 units
    - b. Skyline = exceeded the limit both last year & this; +150 units
    - c. CD permit= apply early & lower levels/initial; renewals are online; Update: Cece will do bi-monthly Permit workshops in 2013-14
    - d. Prof growth advising training is no longer being funded.
  2. Mentor/Teacher program: Kate
    - a. 15 mentors, 7 re-certifications, 2 new applicants

    - a. 14<sup>th</sup> year for Grant. Textbooks, bilingual supports, program services.
    - b. Scope of Work approved: 2013-14 is last year of Cycle 2
