III.	Project Proposals / Discussion PROPOSAL 1 Additional in-class Supplemental Instruction for ENGL/READ 826. We have additional outside class as well. Cost = \$1,280 for just in-class, \$2,560 for inclass and outside class Comparison group (Margaret). Total = \$2,560 per semester x 3 semesters \$7,680	All	120 min

PROPOSAL 4

Spring 2012 SEP Follow up Activity for ESL and Basic Skills Students Plan (all students not already in a Learning Community)

Early in Spring 2012, the first two weeks of February, the Basic Skills Counselor with other counselors as necessary visits ESL and Basic Skills classrooms to follow up with students on their SEPs, petitions for ACE Awards and English for the Workforce Awards, and shares information about the PASS Certificate and ECE Certificates. For ESL and Basic Skills classes where the majority (or all) the students are new, the counselors can get the students started on their SEPs since there isn't be a Transfer Discipline Parade event in the Spring.

- 1. 10 hours for on campus ESL: 5 hours for day classes and 5 hours for evening classes (Level 1-4 ESL Grammar Writing classes and ESL 400)
- 2. 14 hours for off campus ESL (8 CBET, 2 ESL + ECE learning communities and 2 ESL classes @ Sequoia Adult School)
- 3. __ hours for Basic Skills classes
 Cost: 25 MATH, 16 ENGL/READ, 35 ESL = 76
 total counseling hours

Total = \$5,500

PROPOSAL 5

Pathways Poster: As soon as possible, we would like to make posters for the ESL Pathways we have identified for students. The idea is to present these pathways in a visual way to help students see the courses that they need to take to reach transfer level English and the PASS Certificate, ECE and ESL pathway, ACE Award pathway with other courses, and English for the Workforce Award pathway.

We have tried to put some ideas together, but it would be helpful to hire a student in Multimedia Art to create poster design that represent the pathways in a clear and consistent way. Cost: stipend for student artist \$500; printing cost \$500

Total = \$1,000

Above proposals focused on supplemental instruction, counseling, professional development for learning communities, additional support for learning communities/math (SI or Counseling; hours or LC).

PROPOSAL 6: FOR BASIC SKILLS COORDINATOR

Continuing Coordinator/ Counselor position? Currently funded through June 2012 Position proposed by VPI Perkins: Writing Center Director / Basic Skills Coordinator. Writing Center Director would help Basic Skills and Transfer students, would be funded 75% basic skills, 25% Measure G. Non-tenure track faculty person. Should work across the curriculum (not just English/ESL). Work with Math, Work Force, Transfer, etc. Learning Center would be a good place to be based.

Would free up counseling hours. Carla Stoner Brito would be temporary full-time in counseling, focused on basic skills. We don't' want to lose those counseling hours.

Forward two proposals together:

- 1) full time ESL/Basic Skills Counselor (temporary fulltime) [funded 1310 (classes); Measure G (counseling hours)],
- 2) full time Writing Center/Basic Skills Coordinator (non-tenure track faculty position) Position funded 75% basic skills 25% measure G. Writing Center assisting basic skills, ESL, & transfe.

Vice-President of Instruction Perkins will investigate funding Follow up next meeting
