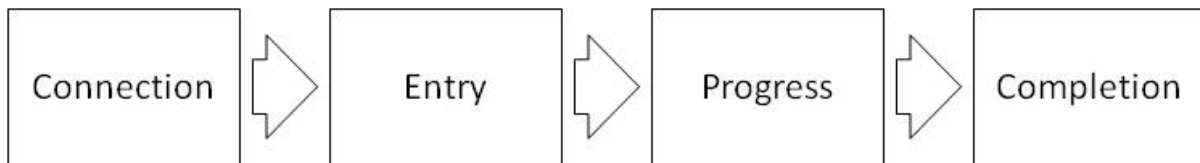


**Cañada College: Educational Master Plan

Task: To identify EMP Objectives for the Completion Strategic Direction

Notes: The Work Group used the Achieving the Dream pathway to guide their discussions. The pathway includes the following four steps.



CONNECTION

1. Enhancing our approach to placement testing
 - a. Raise awareness that it is a high stakes exam
 - b. have students take test in Jr Year of High School
 - c. Brush Up 1 to 2 Hour workshops
2. Orientation
 - a. can we realign and use it to help advise/prepare students for placement test
 - b. can we involve more faculty to engage students more immediately around learning environment model

ENTRY

1. First Semester Pathways
 - a. for Basic Skills
 - b. general transfer
 - c. specific majors (high volume)
 - d. for courses/programs with non-traditional start times
 - i. 17 week, 15 week, 10 week, 12 week, 8+8 week
2. Financial Aid
 - a. 100% FAFSA (underway now)
 - b. Tie distribution it to class attendance
 - i. 2nd check only after making certain progress or completing a in course

PROGRESS

1. Intrusive advising / counseling
 - a. Identify key gatekeeper/momentum point courses
 - i. have counselors adopt those classes & deliver presentation/material in class
 - ii. possible gatekeeper courses: BIO110, PSYC101, ECON101, ECE201, others
 - b. Identify unit thresholds for interventions
 - i. 30 earned units triggers counselor visit (must visit counselor to register)
 - ii. certain size gap between attempted & earned units triggers visit
 - c. Adapt probation/dismissal procedures to force certain course taking and counseling patterns

- d. Achieve excellence in our Early Alert Program
 - i. more formally engage faculty in implementation
- 2. Mentorship programs
 - a. Faculty-student mentorship opportunities
 - b. Student-student mentorship programs

COMPLETION

- 1. Streamline and remove any bureaucratic barriers to receiving certificate/degree
 - a. Make degree audit fully on-line for students
 - b. Can we have students automatically receive their certificate/degree upon satisfactory course completion (rather than forcing the formal petition process)
- 2. Career Center
 - a. better & more robust connections w/ community, faculty, staff
 - b. tightly link with CTE programs
 - c. placement interns
 - d. learn & earn models
- 3. Transfer Center
 - a. connect transfer awareness with transfer gatekeeper courses
 - b. identify incentives to make students choose transfer as goal
