Changes to the AA-T Degree in Social Work & Human Services

Background: The Associate Degrees for Transfer are developed by a team of discipline faculty from the CSU and CCC systems. The Degree “templates” are referred to as Transfer Model Curriculum (TMC’s). A C-ID (course identifier or descriptor) is assigned to all the courses in the TMC. This makes it easier to identify equivalent courses between the Community Colleges. A Faculty Discipline Review Group (FDRG) is formed for each TMC to conduct a five year review of the TMC to insure that it remains relevant.

The FDRG made the following changes to the AA-T Social Work & Human Services TMC:

HMSV 300 Field Experience (3 units) (C-ID SWHS 120) will be divided into two required co-requisite courses:

- SWHS 120A Social Work & Human Services Seminar (1 unit)
Weekly class mtg.; academic component to field work
- SWHS 120B Social Work & Human Services Fieldwork (min. 2 units)
