Articulation Report 9/25/2020

New Assembly Bill (AB) 1460 requires students in the CSU system to take an **Ethnic Studies** course to meet graduation requirements. Beginning 2021-22, the CSU General Education pattern will be revised to add a new Area F Ethnic Studies (3 units). CSU General Education Area D Social Sciences will be reduced from 9 to 6 units. Therefore the unit total of the CSU General Education will remain at 39 units.

AB 1460 defines Ethnic Studies as.... "an interdisciplinary and comparative study of race and ethnicity with special focus on four historically defined racialized core groups: Native Americans, African Americans, Asian Americans, and Latina and Latino Americans."

Community Colleges will likely be prompted to submit courses for the new CSUGE Area F Ethnic Studies this December, for approval dates effective Fall 2021. Here are the courses that currently satisfy Ethnic Studies for Cañada's local AA/AS Degrees:
