Currently enrolled CSM students can borrow technology and equipment from the CSM Library. Technology cannot be placed on hold and is available on a first come, first served basis. Technology includes laptops, headphones, and calculators. Please have your student ID or photo ID ready for check out.

Step 1: Go to the CSM Library to request technology or call the library to check availability

Come to the library check-out desk during open hours to request technology, or call ahead to see what's available.

You can also check availability below by clicking on the image or item below and look at the "Locations" section to see what's currently available in the CSM Library (CSM Tech Request Center). Items showing a status of "Available" or "Not loanable" are still available for check out; only items showing "On holdshelf" or "On loan until" are unavailable for check out.

Step 2: Verify enrollment and sign the loan agreement

Your enrollment will be verified and you will be required to sign a Technology User Agreement Form.

Step 3: Show your valid photo ID

Present a valido photo ID (student ID, driver's license, state ID, passport).

Step 4: Borrow technology and take it home


Technology items will be checked out to you. Please note: **All check out periods are subject to change**. It is your responsibility as the borrow to track due dates. You can check due dates by logging in to your <u>OneSearch account (go to Sign In)</u>.

Step 5: Check-in and return your technology by the due date

Return technology with all peripherals by the due date to maintain your library technology privileges. Students can return technology in-person at the <u>CSM Library during open hours</u>. Do not return technology to campus bookdrops; putting technology in bookdrops can cause serious damage.

Please note: Technology **cannot** be kept between semesters as library staff need to do routine maintenance on the technology to prepare it for the following semester; please contact the library is you are experiencing extenuating circumstances that may delay your return. Keeping technology without informing the library staff may impact technology borrowing privileges. All CSM Library Technology must be returned to College of San Mateo.

CSM Library Computer Labs


The CSM Library has over 50 PC computers and two Macintosh computers available for students to use in its two computer lab areas on the main floor. There is no time limit for students using these computers.

All PC computers are loaded with the following software: Firefox, Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, Adobe Suite (Acrobat DC, Dreamweaver, Illustrator, InDesign, Lightroom, Photoshop), Microsoft Suite (Access, Excel, Powerpoint, & Word), Arduino IDE, Blender, FSReader 3.0, Fusion 2020, JAWS 2020, Kurzweil 3000, MakerBot, Pearson Sign In, QuickBooks Premier & File Manager, Ultimaker Cura 3.6.0, VLC Media Player, ZoomText 2020, and Zoom. Students are not able to download third party software on library computers.

Other Equipment

The CSM Library has a KIC scanner/book scanner (including scan to email or USB) and an e-image Datab ScanPro microform viewer (microfiche and microfilm) available for use.
