## Enrollments

Indicates a duplicated headcount that is the sum of end-of-term enrollments.
\% Retention
The percentage of enrollments with a grade of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, at end-of-term (only excludes W's).

## \% Success

Also known as "successful course completion." The percentage of enrollments with a grade of $A, B, C$, or $P$ at end-of-term.

## First Generation

Students whose parent(s)/ guardian(s) did not have a 4 -year degree.

## Low Income

Students who received any of the following financial aid awards: Pell; CCPG A/B/D; CARE; Federal Work-Study; SEOG; and Chafee grant.
