- Propose budget assumptions
- Review revenue sources
- Prepare budget scenarios, including short and long-term planning
- Integrate the district strategic plan into the budget
- Advise the DSGC on the fiscal impact of district-wide initiatives
- Look outward/forward on strategic issues
- Communicate about budget issues both to the represented constituencies and communities and to the DSGC
- Educate the district community and foster discussion about budget issues
