Federal and State protected classes include: race; color; national origin, ancestry or citizenship status; religion or creed; age; marital status; sex and gender (including sexual orientation and identity; gender identity and gender expression); physical or mental disability; genetic information; medical condition; political activities or affiliations; military or veteran status; status as a victim of domestic violence, assault or stalking or because one is perceived to have one or more of the foregoing characteristics or associates with a person or group with one or more of these characteristics.
