SECTION 09 30 13 CERAMIC TILE Design Standard

PART 1 GENERAL

1.1 PURPOSE:

Ceramic tile design standards are intended to provide an easy a durable, easy to maintain facility that recognizes human perception and the need for construction efficiency.


San Mateo County Community College District is strongly committed to promoting sustainability throughout their campus projects. Section 01 81 13 Sustainability of the Design Standard provides guidelines and recommendations for implementing sustainability strategies. Where relevant, specific sustainability criteria is noted in this section; however; each project team should review and cross reference that front section while developing the specific project and its documentation. Each discipline shall conform that specific performance and manufacturer information provided in the specification section is in alignment with code requirements, LEED criteria, and any other goals for sustainability.

PART 2 PRODUCT

2.1 FLOOR TILES

Random mosaic, multi-color ceramic tile floor not only adds visual interest, but its colors were selected very deliberately to camouflage the stains and dirt that are cleaned on a daily basis, but may detract from the overall clean feeling of the restroom between cleanings.


- A. Taupe colored grout is intentionally used on both the wall and floor tiles. The grout color naturally minimizes the appearance of stains. By using the same grout on walls and floors, the installer can complete the work in a single application, for economy of scale, thus reducing the cost to the District.
- B. The variety of tiles is maintained at an acceptable number to satisfy both visual interest and reasonableness in attic stock.
 - In the event that wall tiles are broken and require replacement, there are only 4 possible tile options that the maintenance/repair personnel have to rummage through attic stock to find.
- In the event that floor tiles are broken and require replacement, there are only 5 possible tile options – and if it's one of the 2 X 2 mosaic tiles, any color will suffice because of the random pattern.
- 3. In either case, the taupe grout color remains the same.



2.2 WALL TILES

- A. Wall tiles start above a built-up cove tile base. They are arranged stack bond pattern.
- B. An accent band in tile is set 6 full field tile units above the base. The accent band consists of
 - two 1"x 6" liner bands bracketing a single run of standard 6"x 6" wall tiles. The liners shall be arranged so that the joint lines are offset from the field tiles in a 25/75% arrangement. Both top and bottom liners shall have offsets which oppose each other. The 6"x 6" tile in the middle of the accent band shall be set offset from the field by 50%.
- C. The wall tile height is set at approximately 6" below the ceiling line (as close to 6" inches without cutting tile); this allows the wall tile to be high enough that graffiti is limited to the easily-cleaned tile surface instead of painted gypboard, yet the tile is stopped below the ceiling line so that the effort and associated cost of scribing tiles to an imperfect ceiling line is voided.







Floor Tile

All floor tile shall be as manufactured by DalTile, Keystones style, in 2"x2" squares, randomly mixed as indicated in the table below.
