2014 Winter Storm

CSM Emergency Evacuation Center

December 11, 2014

- Severe Weather and flooding throughout San Mateo County
- 100s of residents displaced from their homes due to flooding and unsafe living conditions.
- CSM was activated by the San Mateo County
 Office of Emergency Services as an Emergency
 Evacuation Center







Time Line

❖ December 11, 2014

- ➤ 2:15pm Public Safety received calls from the Office of Emergency Services and Human Services Agency requesting CSM be on call as an Emergency Shelter
- > 8:30pm CSM was activated as an Emergency Evacuation Center
 - > All three gyms in Building 8 were set up
- > 9:30pm ~30 displaced people came to the Center

❖ December 12-14, 2014

- > Approximately 100 displaced people remained at the Center
- County Services successfully helping people to find alternate housing

❖ December 15-16, 2014

Approximately 100 displaced people remained at the Center

❖ December 17, 2104

People continue to find alternate housing

❖ December 18, 2014

Demobilization and restoration of the gyms for academic instruction


