

C10 Qualification Evaluation Criteria

- Professional licensure in good standing
- Bonding Capacity
- Verified successful completion of comparable projects
 - Zero lost time accidents
 - Client satisfaction with cut-over coordination

- Firms not yet qualified with SMCCCD will submit full application
- Firms already qualified with SMCCCD for 2010 will submit supplemental questions only
