SMCCCD's Contractor Prequalification

- Public Contract Code §10160 et seq gives community colleges the option to prequalify construction contractors up to four times annually.
- **SMCCCD's Board of Trustees** has **mandated** that we prequalify contractors, as a quality control best practice.
- SMCCCD prequalifies contractors on an annual basis, for a calendar year period.
- Only the pool of prequalified contractors may bid on public works projects in that period.
- If the pool is inadequate, we will ensure the bidding pool is expanded through subsequent mid-year prequalification efforts or project-specific qualification initiatives.



- Prevailing Wage Provisions
- Insurance Requirements—OCIP
- Bonding/Financial Information
- Ability to execute District's Construction Contract







Contractor Prequalification Process

- On-line Application
- Access to Application requires a user ID and password
- 2009 Prequalified Contractors can re-qualify, their 2009 assigned user ID and password will be reactivated
- New Contractors can request access emailing plan@smccd.edu
 - "Contractor Prequalification" in the subject line
- Construction Planning Dept. will email assigned user name and password

Application Lessons Learned

- On-line Application
 - Print the application worksheet for your reference
 - Email address of person submitting is the email address though which we'll communicate
 - Uploaded documents should be in PDF format
 - Financial Statements need to be either Audited or Certified
 - Once application is submitted it is locked and no further edits can be made

Prequalification Clarification

- All contractors who enter into prime contracts with the District must be pre-qualified to bid
- The District will not accept bids from contractors that are not pre-qualified
- Subcontractors that are bidding to general contractors <u>do not</u> have to be prequalified
- Specialty contractors are strongly encouraged to participate in this pre-qualification effort, as the District often has needs for smaller projects and is able to contract directly with specialty contractors
