CLARIFICATIONS

AD3.1 Pre-Bid Questions:

Question #1: Are the subcontractor listing requirements anticipated to be per the Cal State Listing Law of 1/2 of 1% or are all subcontractors requested, regardless of value?

Answer: Bidders must list the name and address of each subcontractor who will perform work at contract price exceeding 1/2 of 1% of the prime's total bid.

Question #2: What is expected to be included in the major equipment and material listing provided at bid time?

Answer: No schedule of major equipment and material suppliers are required for this project.

Question #3: The schedule duration is listed as both 40 and 43 days throughout the Division 1 specification. Which is correct?

Answer: See Addendum #2, dated April 11, 2007. Construction duration is 62 days.

Question #4: In the Table of Contents, Section 01385 Labor Compliance is included and 01395 Project Stabilization is listed as N/A. In the actual sections, 01385 is not included and 01395 is. Please clarify labor requirements for this project.

Answer: Section 01385 Labor Compliance is **not** used for this project. Section 01395 Project Stabilization is **not** used for this project.

Question #5 : Section 07269 refers to a unit price for sealing of 2,000 sq.ft. of slab. There is no space on the bid form for a unit price. Should we assume that the base bid will include the cost to perform this work on 2,000 sq.ft. and that no unit price is required?

Answer: Yes, include the cost to seal 2,000 sq.ft. of slab in the base bid.

AD3.2 Substitution Request:

1. Section 10100 - Visual Display Surfaces: Visual Display Boards by Polyvision Corporation are acceptable substitutions for the manufacturer specified. Visual Display Boards are to be horizontal sliding per Polyvision's "H" Series.
