# New Electric Vehicles on Campus!

As part of the construction of the two new Facilities Maintenance Centers (FMCs) at Cañada College and Skyline College, each campus (including CSM) was given the opportunity to procure electric vehicles. The electric vehicles will contribute to the FMC projects achieving LEED (Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design) certi-



fication. As carbon emissions and dependence on fossil fuels continue to rise, it is important to change our perception of transportation and vehicle fleet operations. By using all-electric vehicles that produce zero tailpipe emissions, we are facilitating change to ensure a livable future – all while still providing each campus with a vehicle that supports our maintenance operations. Miles electric vehicles can be charged at any standard 100v wall socket and have a driving range of 30-40 miles per charge. They have a spacious 7'5" x 4'6" bed with fold down gates for easy loading and unloading. The battery life is up to 25,000 hours of use and the vehicle requires 90% less maintenance than a gas powered vehicle. Not only are our zero emissions all electric, low speed vehicles ideally suited for maintenance operations, but they also set the category standard for safety, comfort, quality and value. By driving a MILES electric vehicle, we are reducing the hydro-

carbon footprint and reducing society's dependence on oil. Over the course of a just one year, we can prevent thousands of pounds of emissions and the use of hundreds of gallons of gas. Our Miles electric vehicles at each campus are creating a world without emissions. Facilities is once again leading the way through positive change and working to make a sustainable difference that will benefit the environment today and for generations to come.
