Members were also informed that Gerry Frassetto, from our District Office, came and spoke to the Diversity Committee as it is our hope to share our committee's work with our District. The committee is also looking into having diversity training for the committee members.</p> <p>David Clay informed members that the Academic Senate does feel that there is nothing more important than diversity. Comments were also made from faculty members adding that they did not agree with the decision.</p> <p>Academic Senate Vice President David Clay informed members that the faculty will be discussing this matter again at their next meeting on November 29th at 2:00 p.m. This meeting is an open meeting and encouraged anyone wanting to speak on this topic to attend the meeting. Those not able to attend the meeting can send their comments or remarks to David Clay and he will make sure that they are read at the meeting.</p> <p>Informed members that everyone needs to be coherent on what our hiring needs are and at the same time know that our funding resources are quite limited. Our reserves have been consumed largely in paying for 1310 (Ad Junct salaries) in order to maintain our schedule. Hiring justification requests submitted for faculty are approximately \$669,000 and \$250,000 for classified. We will need to wait for the Basic Skills Task Force recommendation and see if some hiring positions can come out of Basic Skills funds.</p> <p>Commended College Business Officer Vickie Nunes and Financial Analyst Terry Watson for all their work on our college's budget projections for 2008-2009. President Mohr has also asked Vickie and Terry to begin looking at various items in Fund 1 that are encroachments, and also look at new ongoing maintenance costs for new equipment that we will need to maintain.</p>	<p>Thomas Mohr, President</p>
