
PLO Fall 2010

Program Learning Outcome: Library Space. The library will provide a comfortable, safe, quiet and versatile space to enable student learning.



Student survey conducted Fall 2010 in English and Spanish. Forty-six total respondents.

Selected student comments (clustered around particular themes):

It is important for me to find a quiet lace to study and read... the other places are very noisy. This is a great place to study. I can focus in library and understand the material better. It gives me a quiet place to concentrate and focus without any distractions from outside influences. It is the only place on campus where I can study/finish homework in peace with minimal distraction. It is the only quiet place on campus I can get work done!
