Proposal for Reorganization (Discussion)	President Mohr stated that the budget reductions the College is proposing has engineered the need to look at the workloads across the Divisions and bring the best balance while at the same time focusing on support for teaching and learning. 	These are just proposals and would like to know what the Divisions feel. It was noted that there has not been an opportunity to discuss these proposals with the Student Services Division.  The reorganization will go into place July 1, 2009. It was noted that the Budget Office will be working on the College budget in March 2009 and will need to have any changes at that time.  At President Mohr's request, Gregory Stoup, Director of Planning, Research, and Student Success has gone through the Division FTES and developed a report entitled "Analysis of the Proposed Reorganization Plan" for our College. The distribution of workload, organizational coherence, and current FTE assignment by organization were some of the criteria used in developing this document. The document included:  • A current Cañada Org Chart showing departments and divisions with total current FTE for full time faculty, classified staff, and hourly instruction for the President's Office, Vice President of Instruction Office, and Vice of Student Services  • Current FTE assignments by organization segments  • Revised FTE assignments after proposed reorganization  • Revised organizational chart for Instruction showing the revised total FTE for each instructional division  • Current organizational chart for Student Services with revised total FTE
