IPC Co-chair, Sarah Perkins, reviewed hiring timeline-at this meeting we are planning for Cañada College, not just individual divisions or persons but what is best for Cañada.

Academic President, Martin Partlan, discussed the vote and the ranking disseminated from Academic Senate and plans on how to vote in the future process.

Group C (Third Priority) English

SSPC Co-chairs, Eliazer Ayala-Austin and Robin Richards, reported on the process SSPC used to vote on the positions at their meeting on September 29. SSPC voted by using anonymous ballots.

IPC Co-chair, Byron Ramey, reported that at the October 1 meeting, IPC discussed Measure G and possibly some of the positions could be funded by Measure G. IPC voted openly on the positions using dots.

The following positions were brought forward from SSPC: Alt. Media, Articulation Officer, Financial Aid Assistant, Speech, Interior Design, History, Math

The following positions were brought forward from IPC: History, Interior Design, Math, Speech, Astronomy/Physics, Alt. Media

English was not brought forward on either Councils lists.

Dean Castello reiterated that positions funded by Measure G will be funded for four years. Humanities Division discussed the idea of using two adjunct Counselors to do articulation agreements; one to do the Humanities articulation agreements and one to work on Science articulation agreements.

Counseling Chair, Kathy Sammut, reasoned that one person should do the articulation work for continuity and
