

## Advertisement for 2009 SMCCCD Contractor Pre-qualification

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the San Mateo County Community College District, acting through its Governing Board, is seeking to prequalify California State licensed contractors who wish to compete for the award of various construction contracts.

Projects will be located at the District's three campuses: Cañada College, College of San Mateo, and Skyline College. Only contractors that prequalify through this process will be eligible to bid on District projects for calendar year 2009. Trades contractors are strongly encouraged to participate in this pre-qualification effort.

In calendar year 2009, the District anticipates that a variety of projects may bid, including, but not limited to the following:

**Prequalification submittals:** To be considered for the District's 2009 contractor pool, contractors must complete an online application. **Prequalification Conference:** A non-mandatory prequalification conference is scheduled for Monday, November 3, promptly at 10:00 a.m. Interested parties will meet at the SMCCCD Board Room at 3401 CSM Drive, San Mateo, CA 94402.

**Application due date:** Applications must be completed on or before 2 p.m. December 1, 2008.

By successfully completing this prequalification application, contractors will be eligible to bid under the rules established by the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act.
