Skyline College Building 4: Multicultural, Cosmetology & Administration Build-

Skyline College Building 4 is the new home of the Multicultural Center, Cosmetology program, College Administration, and several general assignment classrooms. Building 4 is a 73,228 square foot, 3 story building with 3 large tiered classrooms and 5 general classrooms. In the Cosmetology wing there are 3 classrooms and 4 lab areas. Building 4 is targeting for a Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design (LEED) Gold certification. It is 25% more en-



ergy efficient than comparable buildings on the Skyline campus because of its high performance glazing, high efficiency heating and ventilating systems, and building envelope design and orientation. Room occupancy sensors turn lights off when no one is present. "Cool roof" reflects heat to the sky, and insulation keeps building heat inside. 83% of construction waste was diverted from landfill. 10% of construction materials were manufactured from recycled content and 14% were manufactured locally. Low volatile organic compound (VOC) materials were selected throughout, including carpet, casework and wood products, paints, coatings, adhesives and sealants. Ribbon Cutting ceremonies were held on April 21. Congratulations to the Skyline Team.

College of San Mateo Building 10: College Center

On April 14, 2011, a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony was held for the College of San Mateo's new Building 10, College Center. College Center is a 140,000+ square foot building that is the new home for Administration, Student Services and Instructional classes. The building also houses the college bookstore, cafeteria and dining rooms, enrollment services, learning center, digital media, EOPS, DSPS, and multi-cultural



center. College Center is the largest and tallest building in the San Mateo County Community College District and the tallest building in the City of San Mateo. College Center is 35% more energy efficient and 49% more water efficient than required by building code. College Center is built with green design and is targeted for LEED Gold Certification by the US Green Building Council. One example of green design is the "Cool Roof" technology that is used to reflect as much heat as possible back into the atmosphere to decrease the heat load of the building. CSM Facilities staff has gone through extensive training on the building's systems and features in preparation for servicing the space.

- To earn a facilities achievement award by 2011




