

How to select a Health Plan

1. Start with <u>CalPERS Health Plan Search by ZIP Code</u> tool – some plans listed on the <u>Monthly Medical Contribution</u> rate sheet may not be available to you based on your zip code so it's important to start here to see which are applicable.
