Excitingly New: Sign Up for Classes Before Arriving in the US!

For those new students coming to San Mateo Colleges for fall 2015, they are able to register for certain classes upon receiving their F-1 visa but before they step on the American soil! This saves a significant amount of time for the students and helps them transition into the new environment. New students are still required to participate in on campus orientation before classes start in the fall. New students will receive the details of this exciting new service directly from their respective college.

How We Did It: the Largest Transfer Partnership

The foundation for San Mateo Colleges to have the largest number of universities providing guarantee transfer, compared to other community colleges, is the base of close to 90 universities that have course articulation agreements (co-recognition of classes) with our 3 colleges. Among them are Academy of Art University, The Art Institute of California, Gonzaga University, University of Southern California (USC), UC Berkley, UCLA, UCSF, University of Maryland, University of the Pacific, and many more. While not all of them offer guaranteed transfer, our students find it much easier to apply for transfer with universities that have course articulation.



Excitingly New: Our Own Intensive English Program and Summer Camps

The San Mateo Colleges are pleased to share with you two exciting new international student initiatives currently in development by our Community, Continuing and Corporate Education (CCCE) department. The first exciting initiative is the development of the **Silicon Valley Intensive English Program (SVIEP) at Cañada College**, which will provide full-time intensive English instruction to international students from around the world on our college campus, and, once complete, enable them to matriculate directly into our transfer program at any of the 3 San Mateo Colleges.

The second exciting initiative under development is an **English Language Summer Camp** (for summer 2016), which will provide exciting and enriching opportunities for international youth to improve their English, to experience Silicon Valley and tour the San Francisco Bay Area, and to learn more about the community college transfer from officials of the San Mateo Colleges, UC Berkeley, Stanford University, and more.
